

There are many types of carpet fibres available, to suit different requirements, tastes and budgets. So which one is best for you and your home? Read on to find out.

# **Wool Fibres**

Wool fibres are a popular choice for carpeting, because they are natural, luxurious and come in a wide range of finishes and colours. A renewable resource, wool is the preferred flooring choice for many people, due to its classic style.

#### **Durability and resilience**

Wool fibres are extremely strong and long-lasting, giving wool carpeting excellent backbounce properties which allows the carpet to retain its original appearance after compression. If properly looked after and maintained, wool carpet fibres offer superior durability.

# Easy cleaning

Chemical stain resistance treatments are not necessary for wool carpeting. Wool's unique fibre structure of microscopic, overlapping scales (similar to tiny roof shingles) make it durable and hardwearing, while stopping dirt from adhering to the fibres.

Wool also does not attract lint, making vacuuming easier and when wet cleaning, the wool fibres swell and release dirt particles, to enable easy clean-up.

#### **Environmental benefits**

Wool is a natural product, rather than being man-made and grows continuously on grazing sheep. Additionally in landfill, wool will decompose leaving no harmful residues.

# Soft to the touch

Wool's unique texture and springiness, combined with its luxurious warmth will leave you wanting to walk around barefoot all day.

## **Health benefits**

Wool has the unique property to be hypo-allergenic and does not promote the growth of dust mites or bacteria or give off any harmful emissions.





# **Nylon Fibres**

Advancements in technology and manufacturing mean that synthetic carpets have come a long way since they were first introduced. Synthetic nylon carpet can have just as many benefits as wool carpets and because of its affordability, nylon carpet is often the preferred carpet fibre for many Australian homes.

## Versatility and choice

Nylon is very versatile and can come in a wide range of colours and can be found in both cut pile and loop pile styles. The wide range of different types available means it will suit many different styles of homes.

## **Durability**

Nylon is constructed to be a very strong fibre and it stands up very well to abrasion, making it fantastic for high-traffic areas like hallways, the living room or kids bedrooms. It's also highly durable and has great "yarn memory" which prevents crushing of your carpet, meaning it will look fresh and new for longer.

## Soil and stain resistant

Nylon carpeting is manufactured and designed with superior stain resistance, as well as being resistant to dirt, as the fibre is better at resisting the absorption of fluids and dirt, making it perfect for high-traffic areas in your home or for commercial areas, where accidental spills may occur.

Nylon carpets are more stain resistant than other types of carpet, as nylon is water resistant meaning that most spills and accidents can be cleaned up with a quick vacuum or spot cleaning.

#### **Fade resistance**

Nylon carpets fibres are fade resistant, making them perfectly suited for those areas that are exposed to direct sunlight, like areas near large windows. There are not many places in the home where nylon carpeting would not suit!

## Value for money

Nylon carpeting is readily available at all price points; it's a versatile fibre that can be used in cost-effective carpeting for investment of first homes, but it is also suitable for higher-end products to suit your forever home.

# Polypropylene fibres

Polypropylene, also known as Olefin, is another synthetic carpet fibre, similar to Nylon. Its wool-like appearance, practicality and low-price point makes it a very popular choice as a flooring option.

## **Highly stain resistant**

Polypropylene fibres are highly resistant to staining because they are hydrophobic, meaning that they do not absorb liquid. Because of this characteristic they cannot be dyed like regular carpet fibres, but instead the colour of the polypropylene carpets fibres is added to the during production.. Because of this manufacturing process, solution-dyed fibres have no open dye sites, so there is nowhere for stains to attach to.

#### A practical choice

Due to their unique manufacturing process, polypropylene carpets offer excellent fade and stain resistance. The fibre dries quickly when wet and so is not prone to mould or mildew as a result of the moisture.

#### Easy to clean

Polypropylene fibre carpets are very easy to clean due to their stain resistance, making them the perfect choice in rooms where the carpets may be subjected to unexpected spills, like dining rooms, children's bedrooms, and playrooms.





One of the first questions that you need to ask yourself when it comes to choosing new flooring for your home is whether you'd like walking on hard or soft flooring? This can depend on the function of the room, what your priorities are (i.e. comfort versus durability) and what look you are trying to achieve.

If you have decided for hard flooring, then you have even more decisions to make! There are a wide range of hard flooring options available and the most popular include engineered timber floorboards and laminate planks only mention a few.

All have different benefits and what you choose mainly depends on your preferences, needs and budget. Let's go through some of the features of each type of flooring and why they could be a suitable flooring choice for your home!

# Laminate: easy to maintain and inexpensive

There are so many reasons why people choose laminate flooring for their homes, but some of the main benefits of laminate flooring is how durable and long-lasting it is, it's inexpensive price point and the fact that you can get laminate flooring in a huge range of colours, patterns and styles.

Laminate flooring consists of layers that are adhered together in a lamination process. It has an inner core of wood and this helps to make the floor strong and durable. Instead of being glued or nailed to the subfloor, the flooring is fixed using a 'click and lock' assembly, known as a 'floating floor' system, which means that it is also easy to install yourself!

While laminate flooring may conjure up images of unfashionable patterns on sheet laminate from the 90's, today's laminate can be easily mistaken for wooden floorboards, but at a fraction of the price!

# **Engineered timber:** very durable but requires maintenance

Engineered timber floor, to not confused with timber flooring, is made by joining multiple layers of wood pressed together. These layers of wood are called plys. The visible top layer of an engineered timber plank is called the lamella and is generally made of hard wood such as Blackbutt, Jarrah and Spotted Gum.

Engineered timber flooring is typically more prone to scratches and scuffs than laminate and bamboo which means it needs more maintenance than other flooring types. But on the flip-side, engineered wood offers greater durability and a more realistic look as well as feel.

On average, engineered wood is comparatively more expensive than other flooring options and it comes in a range of price structures right from the bargain prices to luxury styles. The price tag of engineered timber is mainly driven by the thickness of the lamella and its unique characteristic.

## **Laminate flooring**

One of the most robust types of flooring around, laminate is an excellent choice for high-traffic floorspaces. Laminate flooring is a great alternative to expensive, high-maintenance hard-wood timber, offering greater durability with the look and feel of timber.

Many people choose laminate planks for aesthetic appeal, exceptional durability and low-maintenance costs. Unlike hard-wood timber, laminate flooring does not require sanding or polishing as it contains a wear layer to protect the decorative and core layers underneath. However, once worn down or damaged, laminate planks require careful replacement.

# Vinyl flooring

A highly popular choice for hightraffic areas is **vinyl flooring**. Whether choosing vinyl sheets or planks, vinyl looks luxurious, feels incredibly comfortable and is comparable in durability, look and feel to laminate.

To reduce the chances of damaging your vinyl flooring we recommend keeping pet nails trimmed, and having mats at all outdoor entrances to the home, to ensure that outdoor matter is captured before it is walked throughout your home.

- **Design appeal** vinyl flooring can give the same elegance and beauty of timber or stone flooring but at a fraction of the cost.
- Easy installation vinyl flooring comes in sheets or planks, and can be installed professionally, or with care as a DIY project.

# KEEP YOUR VINYL FLOOR LOOKING GREAT

#### **New Floors**

Use a Damp mop immediately. Do not scrub or wash for at least 72 hours.

# Regular Maintenance


- Sweep or vacuum regularly, to remove loose dirt, which can scratch your floor. Note: We do not recommend vacuums that have a beater bar since it can visibly damage your flooring surface. Additionally, we do not recommend electric brooms with hard plastic bottoms with no padding as use may result in discolouration and de-glossing. The use of steam mops or similar is not recommended.
- Wipe up spills as soon as possible. Never use highly abrasive scrubbing tools on any resilient floor.
- Wash your floor regularly with a neutral detergent.
- DO NOT use abrasive cleaners, or "mop and shine" products. These products may leave a dull film on your floor.

- Over time, if the shine on your floor begins to dull, you can apply a Shinekeeper Floor Finish. DO NOT use paste wax or solvent-based polishes.
- Vinyl flooring, like other types of smooth floors, can become slippery when wet. Allow time for floor to dry after washing. Immediately wipe up wet areas from spills, foreign substance, or wet feet.
- Do Not use highly alkaline 'floor strippers' to clean the floor covering. Highly alkaline solutions have the potential to damage the adhesive bonds between the planks.

# Proactive Protection for your Floor

- When moving appliances or heavy furniture it is always wise to lay a plywood panel on your floor and "walk" the item across it. This protects your floor from scuffing and tears.
- Use floor protectors under furniture to reduce indentation. As a general rule of thumb, the heavier the item, the wider the floor protector needed.
- Place a walk-off mat at outside entrances to reduce the amount of dirt brought into your home. We strongly recommend mats without a latex or rubber backing since these backings can cause permanent discolouration.
