CLEANING & MAINTAINING LAMINATE & TIMBER FLOORING

Cleaning your floors

Keep your laminate floors shining beautifully with these simple and easy cleaning tips.

Easily remove dirt and dust with a dry dust mop and if required, vacuum with the hard floor attachment of your vacuum cleaner or wipe occasionally with a lightly dampened cloth mop.

For dirt that is more difficult to remove, use a slightly moist cloth and wipe the surface afterwards with a clean, dry cloth. Under no circumstances should the flooring be wet mopped and laminate cleaners should not be sprayed directly on the flooring, as this may cause the joints to buckle and lift due to excessive spraying,

instead spray it onto a cloth before applying to the stain.

For heavier cleaning, mix household vinegar and water, or household ammonia with warm water. Do not use harsh or abrasive cleaners, soap or detergent based cleaners, waxbased products, or any type of polish on laminate floors, this will cause your floor to look dull and will leave a filmy residue.

If a stain remains, you may remove the worst stains with acetone or denatured alcohol on a soft cloth without bleaching or damaging the floor. Nail polish remover that contains acetone can be used sparingly.

Maintaining your floors

To maximise the durability and beauty of your laminate floor, we recommend the following practices as part of your floor's normal care and maintenance:

- Wipe up accidental household spills immediately with a clean dry cloth.
- Place a doormat outside exterior entrances to collect excess moisture and dirt and stop it from getting on your floor. Dust and dirt such as sand and grit will not only make the floor dirty but can cause premature wear and tear and scratches.
- To prevent scratching from excess dirt and dust, dustmop (dry and clean) or vacuum the floor regularly.
- Use only colourfast and nonscratch carpeting or pads on your floor.
- Avoid sharp or pointed objects with concentrated

weight such as high heels on your floor.

- Use protective furniture coasters and felts pads under furniture legs.
- Rearrange furniture occasionally for increased indentation resistance.
- Do not treat or seal laminate floor panels after they are installed. The floor must not be waxed, varnished or polished. Do not use steel wool or abrasive cleaning methods on the floor panels after they are installed, as it will damage the surface layer of the floor.
- Never sand, lacquer, or refinish laminate flooring surfaces.
- Never use steam cleaners on a laminate floor, as they will swell the boards' joints from the heat.
- Never wet-mop the floor as it will cause swelling of the joints.

FOR EASY STAIN REMOVAL, SIMPLY FOLLOW THE INDICATED SEQUENCES AS DIRECTED BELOW:

Is your carpet looking a little dirty and stained? Follow our easy guide to removing stains to give your carpet a new lease on life.

Getting red wine out of carpet

Red wine is notorious for making its way onto clothing and carpets, and for being a pesky stain to lift. To remove the spillage from your carpet, try using the following method:

- Dab water into the carpet over the stain, press it dry.
- Add some detergent (use 1 teaspoon clear dishwashing liquid to 1 cup warm water), press dry.
- Add some more detergent, press dry.

For more stubborn stains, try:

- Dabbing some detergent into the stain, pressing it dry.
- Putting some household ammonia (undiluted) onto the stain, pressing dry.
- Dabbing some detergent into the stain, pressing it dry.
- Finishing with some lukewarm water and pressing dry.

Getting nail polish off carpet

Nail polish may seem like it would be an incredibly tough stain to get out of your carpet, but the stain removal process is actually really simple. Just pour a touch of non-oily nail polish remover onto the stain and press down with a clean, plain white paper towel. Repeat the process if necessary.

Getting candle wax off carpet

Before you even try to remove candle wax off your carpet, grab an ice cube out the freezer and rub it over the wax to freeze it hard. Once the wax is frozen, break it into pieces and vacuum it up. For a thorough clean, dab some drycleaning solvent on the wax residue and press it dry with a paper towel. Repeat this step as required.

Getting coffee stains out of carpet

The process of removing coffee stains from carpet requires nothing more than some detergent solution, some undiluted white vinegar, and a little bit of patience. Dab the stain with some detergent, followed by some vinegar, more detergent, and then some lukewarm water. Be sure to press the carpet dry with a white paper towel in between each step.

Getting paint off carpet

Different paints require different stain removal methods. So, before you tackle paint stains on your carpet, it's important to know what kind of paint it is you're trying to remove. For paint that is latex-based, you will need some detergent solution, household ammonia, and undiluted white vinegar. Work on the stain by dabbing with detergent, ammonia, vinegar, and then more detergent, pressing dry in between each application. For oil-based paint stains, dab some dry cleaning solvent on and press dry. Follow that with some detergent solution, pressed dry, and finish up with some lukewarm water and another dry. If this process doesn't remove the stain, enlist the help of a professional carpet cleaner.

What is the best carpet?

Carpet selection is based on your personal taste and the needs around your home or office. A clear understanding of your needs will help you choose a carpet that is best for you.

By considering the following factors, you will be on the right path to making an informed decision.

EXPERT TIP

Choose your style of flooring that matches your expectations for your home like, will the area have a lot of foot traffic or not?

Fashion vs function

- What is your style or décor theme?
- Do you want the latest colour options?
- Do you want a plain or textured effect?
- Do you want a functional, hardwearing carpet?

Outdoor/indoor environment

- Are the paths around your home or office sealed or unsealed?
- What is the likelihood of dirt and soil being tracked in?
- Do you entertain in some rooms more than others?

Children and pets

- Do you have a family that spends a lot of time at home?
- What are the high traffic areas around your home?
- What is the likelihood of staining (from mud, pets, food, etc)?

Is the carpet for a home or business environment?

- Do you want to create a certain style?
- In a business environment, does the carpet have to comply with any building regulations such as flammability?

What is your budget?

This is one of the most important questions of all!

Parrys prides itself in achieving great selections within all types of budgets.

How do I know how much I need?

Ideally, a copy of an architects floor plan of your home will help our sales consultants achieve an extremely accurate quantity and price. Alternatively, you could follow our simple "how to measure" guide and bring in your measurements. If you don't have any sizes at all, that still is no hurdle for our experienced sales consultants. All of the above allow you to be able to make your selection, get accurate pricing*, and secure your sale on the spot.

How wide is carpet?

The standard width for carpet in Australia is 3.66 metres; however, some styles of carpet can be produced in widths of 4 metres. The reason for this width measurement is that the machines used to produce carpet are constructed to allow 12 feet (or 3.66 metres) of carpet to be manufactured.

Who will install my new carpet?

Parrys will offer installation as part of the sales package or after-sales service. Installation should be discussed with your sales consultant during the sales negotiation.

Parrys offer a LIFETIME GUARANTEE on the installation of their floor covering^s.

All carpet should be installed on new underlay that is compatible with the quality, and proposed use of your carpet and otherwise in accordance with Australian Standards Association Carpet Installation Recommendations AS2455.

Do you need a special vacuum cleaner for different types of carpet?

It is important to vacuum your carpet thoroughly and frequently, particularly in high traffic areas. Vacuum cleaners fitted with micro filter systems ensure fine particles (such as dustmite allergens) are removed and stay in the collection bag, which is particularly important if you are dust sensitive.

We recommend that you use a different vacuum cleaner for different styles of carpet. For low cut pile carpets, we suggest a vacuum cleaner with a rotating brush that agitates the pile and loosens the soil for easier carpet maintenance. When vacuuming loop pile, cutloop pile or berber carpet, we recommend that you turn the brush off or change the head to prevent excess fuzzing.

Ensure the vacuum is kept in sound mechanical condition and brushes are cleaned and replaced when worn. Regularly check and adjust the height of beaters (if fitted) to ensure the carpet is not damaged by excessive beating. Suction efficiency of vacuum cleaners is reduced considerably when bags are half full. Change or empty dust collection bags frequently and replace filters as recommended by the manufacturer.

Why does the colour of carpet look different at home?

Lighting can change your perception of carpet colour, making it look like particular areas are lighter or darker than others.

Also, during use, pressure on carpet pile causes the pile to lie in different directions creating the effect of "shading". This shading is a characteristic of cut-pile carpets (particularly solid colour). While affecting appearance, it has no detrimental effect on the performance of the carpet.

Will I see the joins in my floorcoverings?

Like the joins in your clothes and furniture fabric, this is the same for your carpet. Two cut edges coming together to make one surface. Different styles of carpet join better and are less visible than others. Unfortunately, nobody can guarantee joins that are completely invisible.

Does having carpet in a house increase airborne dust levels, thus increasing risk to people suffering from asthma and other dust-related allergies?

It has yet to be proven that there is a significant increase in the levels of airborne dust between carpeted and non-carpeted homes. More significantly, there is a misapprehension that having carpet in the home will increase in the exposure to dustmite allergens when in fact there are a range of other triggers in the home that can increase exposure and cause a respiratory reaction.




