

If you or your kids have allergies or asthma, you may be aware that selecting the best type of flooring can have a big impact on the air quality within your home as many allergens can collect and get trapped in the floors.

'As a general rule, wool carpeting is the worst choice for allergies while synthetic carpet or hardwood flooring are regarded as the best.

Ask most immunologists or allergists and they'll tell you that for people who suffer from allergies or asthma, carpeting can be bad news. While it may look fantastic and feel nice underfoot, carpet does have its downside. Not only does it harbor dust, pollen and other allergens, carpet also provides a perfect environment for mould and dust mites to grow. This, coupled with the fact that it is notoriously difficult to deep clean and can also emit Volatile Organic Compounds (VOCs) that can trigger asthma and irritate the eyes, nose and throat, it is no wonder that people are seeking more healthy alternatives.

The key is deciding which ones best suit your look, your lifestyle and your budget. So, whether you're pulling up that old shag, have sanded that hardwood one too many times, or are finally losing the worn-out laminate, the big question is – what to put underfoot?

Best types of floors for those with allergies or asthma

Laminate, timber, hybrid and vinyl are ideal flooring options for those with asthma or allergies

Laminate, timber, hybrid and vinyl are alternative options that are perfect for those with allergies or asthma as they are easy to sweep and mop, yet don't attract dust mites or mould. But remember, not all floors are created equal! With some products, it is a case of 'you get what you pay for' as cheaper options may cause other unforeseen issues after a period of time, which can be an additional expense to rectify.

Regardless of which flooring surface you use, it's important to keep the floors clean. Even solid hardwood, which is often the best choice,



can result in sneezes or watering eyes if not kept fresh. Thankfully, cleaning is simple and dust that has settled on hardwood is far easier to vacuum or wipe away than dirt that is engrained into a carpet (here are some cleaning tips recommend).

When you're renovating your property, either to rent it out or to prepare for immediate sale, Return On Investment (ROI) is a factor in almost every design choice. How much will you get back later for what you spend now? Just as much as upgrading paint, fittings and fixtures, the kind of floors you choose can have a big effect on resale value.

Funnily enough, it is easy to overlook the 'feature factor' of floors when you're renovating. Don't. Floors are the true constant in any home. Think about it: during inspections, interested buyers will walk into every single room of your home. They might touch a few walls here and there and take a look at the ceiling, but they will be standing on the floors at every single moment. Beyond initial visual appeal, the ongoing tactile influence of your floors is subtle, immediate and constant.

Generally, timber floors are the best match for Australia's superb weather. When considered against sandy places, such as beachside properties and most of Western Australia, floating floors often make more practical sense than carpet too.

What are the flooring trends?

Floor trends come and go, but there are underlying themes (pun intended) that endure. Foremost among them is consistency of flooring types. Simply, a home should have a unified flooring concept throughout. That doesn't have to mean one type of floor through the whole house. Rather, it means that the flooring solution matches room use in consistent ways.

For example, bedrooms – which are often carpeted for warmth, comfort and quietness – should each have the same carpet, thus bringing the interior concept together. One point on carpets: while once popular throughout entire homes, over the past 10 years they have been vanishing from dining rooms, living rooms, hallways and entrances.

This may be because hard floors suit high-traffic areas and also, in this era where home presentation is so crucial, they simply look more striking. Nevertheless, both wood and carpet are poor choices for the kitchen, laundry, toilet and bathroom, with their increased risk of spills.



Pros and cons of hard flooring options

While solid timber floors are enduringly popular in Australia, they do not suit every room and every budget.

Let's compare them with the various other kinds of hard flooring options to weigh up the pros and cons.

Before you start

Firstly, when it comes to choosing household flooring that's petfriendly, the most important things to consider and check off are:

- Durability
- · Resistant to scratches
- Stain, moisture and odour resistant
- Easy to clean

That's where the following two styles of flooring can really assist you and your furry friend co-exist.

Vinyl Flooring

Vinyl flooring is one of the best cost-effective flooring options because it's extremely tough, waterproof, and highly resilient to wear and tear. Plus, as one of the easiest flooring types to clean and maintain, it remains a great option for allergy sufferers as hair and dander can be easily swept or mopped away. What's more, vinyl flooring is cool and comfortable for those pets that like lounging around, and as it is quiet underfoot, you won't be woken by your pet's midnight 'zoomies'.

Vinyl is also extremely stylish, and with a huge range of timber-look surfaces, textures and tones it is a fantastic, affordable alternative to timber floors

Laminate

Incredibly tough and scratch-resistant, it is no wonder that Laminate is one of the top flooring choices for households with furry friends. Laminate is a particularly durable and wear-resistant flooring choice because it has an additional external layer and resin coating. Laminate is also very 'low-maintenance' – it has superior stain-resistant properties and is extremely easy to clean.

However, it is important to remember that Laminate is top-layer moisture resistant. Unless cleaned quickly, moisture or puddles left to sit will be absorbed and may cause the flooring to swell and buckle.

When it comes to style, texture and designs, Laminate is also incredibly versatile with a wide range of looks and finishes. It has always been a popular option for pet owners and this trend will continue for some time.

If neither of the options above tick the box, you can also consider carpet.



Carpet

While it doesn't sound like a practical choice, there are now many carpet flooring products that are manufactured specifically for pets. In fact, carpet can be a comfortable, warm and cosy flooring option, especially if your pet is older or starting to feel arthritic.

While carpet will prevent slipping and scratching, it is important you choose a pet-specific range that features a moisture backing. Importantly, you will also need to consider pet proof carpet protection as in many cases, carpet can harbour fleas, hair or unwanted pests like ticks

Carpet is a warm, traditional flooring option that can last many years with pets, however, it can have a short wear life and will probably need to be replaced every ten years or so. If you have your heart set on carpet, make sure you opt for a lower pile and look for options that are durable, stain resistant, and easy to clean.

How Do I Fix Damaged Carpet Disasters?

Disaster #3: Your Carpet Has Stains. Chocolate:
 Use a dull knife to scrape away as much chocolate as possible. If the chocolate is melted, place a resealable plastic bag filled with ice cubes or an ice pack over the stain to harden the remaining chocolate before scraping, then vacuum the area to pick up any loose flakes or pieces. Mix 1/4 teaspoon of liquid dish soap with one cup of warm water, and use a clean cloth to apply the solution to the stain, working from the outside toward the centre. Leave the solution on for at least five minutes, then blot with a paper towel or a clean microfibre cloth until the stain is gone.



Traditional, luxury or hybrid vinyl?

There are three main types of vinyl, namely: traditional vinyl, luxury vinyl and hybrid vinyl.

The common traits they all share such as being durable, waterproof, easy to clean etc. will vary from type to type. Each kind has a different constitution and structure and the production process for each varies so



the characteristics they share will differ to some degree.

Traditional vinyl has a softer texture with cushioned backing and is soft underfoot while still remaining hard wearing and durable. It comes in sheet form for easy installation in most rooms and is also the most affordable option.

Luxury vinyl comes in different thicknesses and is in plank form. It has the ability to replicate the appearance of natural stone or timber, giving a more realistic look.

Hybrid vinyl is built for impact resistance and durability combining the best aspects of vinyl and laminate. It differs from traditional and luxury vinyls in that it's built with a rigid limestone core. This makes it very strong and extremely long lasting while still having the realistic look of the luxury planks

Vinyl sheets or planks?

Vinyl sheets come in a large roll a little like a carpet or linoleum. Sheet flooring usually covers the whole space without leaving any visible seams.

They are made of vinyl resting on a backing sheet of fiberglass and coated with some protected layers of polyurethane to make it even more resilient. Vinyl sheet flooring is fairly robust and can sustain a high amount of traffic. It is usually about 2.5 -3mm thick but can feel softer and warmer underfoot than wood or stone.

100% waterproof: vinyl sheets are waterproof and can be used in bathrooms and kitchens unlike vinyl planks which are only waterresistant.

Designs: they come in any color or pattern, some are designed to look like natural wood while others resemble natural stone or tiles.

Affordable: this vinyl product is usually the most affordable solution as it can be mass produced into huge rolls without having to be cut into smaller pieces. You can find durable vinyl sheets that you can install yourself from as little as \$23.75m².

Vinyl planks

The plank is made from vinyl and attached to an underlayer of fiberglass which makes it very rigid unlike a vinyl sheet, which needs to be rolled out making any rigidity impossible.

Thickness: vinyl planks come in different thicknesses including 2mm or 3mm. Thicker planks may cost more but could save you money in the long run as they will be more hard-wearing and are better suited to parts of the home that are prone to high traffic.

Designs: vinyl planks are usually designed to look like natural wood as they come in planks and lock together in the same way.

Pricing: you can find quality vinyl planks from \$29.90 per square metre. As with everything, thicker planks will cost more but will last longer.

Luxury vinyl

Luxury vinyl is made up of multiple layers pressed together to create a very hard-wearing and natural-looking finish. The top layers include a scratch-resistant protecting surface over an image layer that holds the color and design. Beneath these are several layers of fiberglass, moisture-resistant backing, and an impact resistant core. Luxury vinyl planks usually come in a choice of 4.5mm and 5mm thickness.

100% waterproof: luxury vinyl planks are completely waterproof and can be used anywhere in the home.

Design: they look entirely natural and can be more hardwearing than wood or stone. Some are so resilient they are used in commercial areas.

Pricing: luxury vinyl flooring is the most costly option but also the most resilient which could work out cheaper in the long run. You can find luxury vinyl planks from \$42.90 per square metre.
