By far the most common question our team get asked is the best way to care for their new flooring – especially carpet! Not only does your carpet bring warmth and comfort but it is also an investment that, if well looked after, will maintain its quality for years to come.

#### **Spot Cleaning**

Like most textiles, carpet is not considered to be 100% stain proof which means that when accidents happen, a speedy response is definitely the key. The aim here is to deal with the stain before they manage to soak into the carpet fibres because, once the stain sets, it will become a lot harder to remove. Use a high-quality stain remover and make sure you read the instructions closely to avoid any unwanted damage to your carpet. Also, don't forget that many carpets are stain resistant to provide that additional protection if needed.

#### **Regular Vacuuming**

By far the simplest and most effective way to maintain the life of your carpet and keep it looking great is through comprehensive and frequent vacuuming.

Ideally, your vacuuming routine should begin as soon as possible after your carpet has been laid. In this first week, you will find that regular vacuuming to be the ideal way to remove excess and remnant dust and fibres. From then on, make sure you give the carpet a go-over several times a week to remove dirt from the surface and prevent it from sinking deeper into the pile.

It is important to note that even the direction you vacuum can have an impact on the cleanliness of your carpet. Simple rule of thumb is that vacuuming against the pile lifts the dirt, while the opposite direction helps to leave a uniform and consistent finish.

It goes without saying that the quality and type of your vacuum cleaner is integral to how well your carpet is maintained and the best vacuum head to use is dependent on your carpet type. For example, a vacuum with a rotating brush is ideal for a low-cut pile carpet as it loosens the soil for easier cleaning, while for a loop or cut loop pile carpet, a brushless head often produces optimum results. Make sure that your vacuum is kept in good condition and that the brushes are regularly cleaned and maintained. Remember that even a half full vacuum bag can drastically reduce the effectiveness of the machine, so make sure you empty them regularly.

#### **Steam Cleaning**

One aspect of carpet care that is often overlooked is steam cleaning which should be done approximately every 18 months. Steam cleaning helps to remove stubborn dirt and grime and is a great way to bring your carpet back to life.

While many people be tempted to undertake DIY steam cleaning, we strongly recommend that this only be undertaken by a professional and accredited carpet cleaner.

#### Other things to consider

With furniture, make sure you use appropriately sized leg protectors, and you can fix those unsightly pressure marks by occasionally rearranging your furniture.

Castor wheels were often seen as the enemy of carpet, and care definitely needs to be taken when moving furniture with wheels. Make sure you invest in some quality furniture coasters to help even out the weight.

What many people don't realise is that prolonged exposure to direct sunlight can cause permanent colour loss to your carpet. Even though Australian manufacturers have taken this into account and have applied UV treated products to help reduce this colour loss, Western Australia is a very sunny place; so make sure you protect your carpet by selecting an appropriate window cover like curtains or blinds to reduce the exposure to direct sunlight.

As previously mentioned, your flooring is one of your major expenses when designing your home. Treat it like such and it will give you a high level of satisfaction for years to come.

Can laminate be installed on top of existing flooring?

## Can laminate be installed on top of EXISTING FOORING?

#### The short answer to this question is 'yes'.

But, there are a few things you need to consider before you go ahead and install laminate over your existing flooring.

The type of flooring you are laying laminate over is very important, as not every surface is made equal. As a rule of thumb, if your existing flooring is level and smooth, laminate can easily be laid over top. This rules out brick, carpet and natural stone floors.

More uniform flooring like concrete, vinyl, tile and plywood, are all easy to lay laminate over, but you will need to make sure an underlay has gone down before laying your new floor.

#### What is a laminate underlay?

A laminate underlay is basically a thin, flexible and soft layer of cushioning that is laid between the sub-floor/existing flooring and the laminate. The most common types of underlay are foam, rubber or felt.

#### Why do I need to use a laminate underlay?

Underlays are essential when installing laminate flooring over a subfloor, or existing floor like tiles. Not only does an underlay improve the look and quality of the finished laminate, but it acts as a barrier between the laminate and the flooring, creating a perfectly level surface and protecting the laminate from any damage. Most importantly, it protects from any moisture that might come through from the sub-floor, particularly from a concrete slab.

Underlays also absorb sound when you walk on the laminate and act as insulation, all making for a great under-foot feel.

#### Which laminate underlay is best?

There are a few major factors to consider when choosing the right underlay.

- · What is your existing flooring made of?
- Does your laminate come with inbuilt underlay or does it need to be purchased separately?
- What sort of noise reduction and insulation do you want?
- What is your budget?

It is all important when making the decision on what underlay to choose.

Rubber underlays are the most popular and universal. They are hardy, breathable and have a bit of bounce to them, making your floor a lot softer under your feet. But, rubber can tend to be a bit more on the wallet.

For a cheaper alternative, consider a foam underlay. These days, the quality of foam underlays is very comparable to rubber.

If you require more noise reduction and insulation, opt for the thick and heavy felt. Although it is the most expensive option and is most often used for commercial buildings, it is the best option for anyone looking for a high level of comfort, quiet and warmth.

## How to Prepare Concrete for Glued Down Vinyl Floors.

One of the products we sell at Parrys is vinyl. Vinyl can come in two forms, a sheet vinyl which is four metre wide and laid loose over the floor and the other is vinyl planks, as you can see here, which are glued directly to the ground.

These vinyl planks are very flexible, which is the same with a sheet vinyl, so it is imperative that we get the subfloor right to make sure it's a perfect smooth floor.

So the first thing we have to do is check our concrete floors for any cracks or holes. It's a bit like painting a wall; if you paint a wall and there is a hole there, the paint is going to collapse into it. Vinyl will fall into these similar holes in the ground, so patch them up first with some sort of concrete compound.

The second thing we do is look for any humps or bumps in the floor. We need to grind them down because humps and bumps will show with a flexible product like this that hugs the floor.

Once all that's done, make sure you wash your floors with water and detergent. Let them dry out completely, and then you have your perfect floor to start laying your vinyl.

## What Kind of Carpet Will Suit You?

My grandmother had wool carpets. Her mum probably had wool carpets. And if carpet was around, maybe her mum did too. When selecting carpet in today's world it comes down to feel, colour, design, texture, and all those things. So apart from wool carpets, we now have man-made fibres like polyester, nylon, and polypropylene.

Wool and nylon are the only two carpets that are fire rated. So if you have an apartment or commercial situations, then they are the carpets you need to choose. Wool on the other hand can get fuzzy, or 'pill' is the appropriate word. So if you have a wool carpet, loose wool can come out and can float around through your house. This does not happen in the man-made fibre carpets.

When comparing Polyester and Nylon, Polyester sometimes is softer than nylon, but nylon is a lot more durable than the polyester carpet. So if you are putting a carpet on a staircase, for example, nylon will work a lot better than a polyester carpet.

Polypropylene carpets are fantastic because they are budget entry level carpets. They are perfect for rental properties. If you own an investment property, lay a polypropylene carpet and it will last for a long, long time. So at the end of the day, it all depends on which way you want to go, and the application that is needed.



One of the most common questions our team get asked is whether a quality vacuum cleaner really makes any difference, and our answer is always the same – Yes!

If you are going to invest your hard-earned money into a lovely floor, then it makes sense to also invest in a good machine to look after it for years to come. That said, while regular vacuuming can literally extend your carpet's life, don't forget that the type of cleaner and floor head you use is often equally as important. If you are in the market for a new vacuum, a couple of things to look out for include easy to use features that allow you to adjust the height, beater bar rotation and fan speed. Every carpet has unique properties, and it may take a bit of trial and error to find the ideal settings to get the best out of your new machine.

#### Adjustable Beater bar

We believe that adjustable beater bar height is the most important feature to look for, as this enables your machine to be used on a wide variety of carpet types. If your vacuum is set too high above the carpet surface, it won't attract the gritty soil below, whereas if the setting is too low, the beater bar or brushes may damage the carpet surface, causing it to look worn and frayed.

#### Do I need an expensive vacuum cleaner?

The simple answer is No. While we know there is a huge variance in the price of vacuums, we do recommend avoiding the cheapest solution where possible. Instead, look at what you can afford, what type of flooring you have and do a bit of research – We are sure you will find an affordable vacuum to meet your requirements.

#### Do I choose an upright or cylinder vacuum cleaner?

Again, the answer is really a personal preference as both types are suitable for cleaning carpets – However, there are some subtle differences between the two. While upright cleaners help combat pet hair with their beater bar and typically have larger heads to cover more surface area, the light, compact cylinder models are ideal for smaller houses and suit a wide range of surfaces, including hard floors, rugs and carpets.

#### **Additional advice**

Remember, to maintain peak performance, it is important to keep your vacuum hose and attachments free from foreign objects. We also recommend regular inspections of the head to ensure that there are no rough/sharp edges or bent bits of metal which could damage the carpet.

# Wool What to expect

While many people may know the basic differences between a natural wool carpet and a synthetic one, it is important to also understand what you can expect when your wool carpet is newly installed.

#### Sprouting

Weird in name but quite common in nature, 'sprouting' is when a single tuft lifts from the **carpets pile** surface. In most situations, sprouting can be easily rectified in a cut pile carpet by gently trimming the tufts with a pair of sharp scissors but make sure you do not pull the tuft, as this could further damage the area.

If you have a loop pile carpet do not cut the tuft! *Instead, please* contact the experience team at Parrys to discuss your options – which may involve professional repair.

#### Fluffing

If you notice your vacuum filling up with bits of fibre from your next carpet – do not be alarmed as this is just remnants of fibre from when the carpet was manufactured. Known as 'fluffing', these little fibre balls commonly appear on the surface of new carpets and while they may seem unsightly at first, they will soon vanish after several thorough vacuums.

On loop pile carpets, you may find this fluff is harder to dislodge, but a strong vacuum should normally do the trick.

#### Tracking vs. permanent shading

There is no doubt that many of you would have experienced 'tracking', which is when imprints are left by your footprints on the carpet surface.

Tracking is most common with plusher type carpets, and while it will disappear with a thorough vacuum, it will also likely reappear next time the carpet is walked on. As such, it is important to make sure you pay extra attention to those areas with high foot traffic like hallways.

Likewise, if you have a plush or cut pile carpet, you may notice that it develops lighter or darker patches over time. This is known as

"shading" and happens when the carpet fibres are permanently bent or folded over. While it is impossible to predict where and when shading may occur, it is most often related to where the carpet is located.

Shading does not affect the durability of the carpet and can appear several months after installation.

#### Fading

Unsurprisingly, if parts of your wool carpet are exposed to direct sunlight there is, over time, the chance that it may fade or discolour. While this can affect all carpets, there are some types that are more fade resistant than others. So, if your carpet is likely to see a lot of sun, make sure you do your research into which types of carpet are best. Alternatively, pop into one of our Parrys stores and our experienced team can help shine the light on what is appropriate for you.

#### **Furniture marks**

When using heavy furniture, it is important to remember to use furniture cups and move the furniture regularly (a few centimetres is fine) to prevent unsightly indentations and damage to your carpet.
