



HOW TO BUY THE RIGHT CARPET FOR YOUR HOME

Carpets are available in all manner of colours, fibres, materials and finishes. This is great as it gives the buyer a choice, but it presents an unlikely dilemma. With so many factors impacting on your decision to purchase, you need to take the appropriate steps to ensure that you land what works for you. Below are some key considerations.

1. Decide on a carpet material

Your choices in this regard include natural wool, nylon, polypropylene or polyester.

Wool is one of the most beloved materials out there, mostly because it is purely natural, dense, soft to the touch and hides dirt pretty well.

Nylon is a strong fiber, highly resistant to abrasions, easy to maintain and static-free.

Polypropylene is colorfast but prone to matting and general pressure. Still, it makes up 80% of commercial carpet installations.

Polyester has a luxurious feel and is resistant to water but doesn't hold on to its fibres under pressure. It also fades under direct, heavy sunlight.

2. Decide on a carpet finish

Here, the classifications are cut pile, loop and cut-loop.

A cut pile carpet – such as cut pile twist or cut pile plush – will have yarns cut off at the two opposite ends. It has a soft aura about it, and this makes it ideal for bedrooms and living rooms.

A loop carpet – such as level loop pile or high/low loop pile – has distinctive yarns that have been looped and cut on its surface. Sometimes, you have low piles. At others, you have tightly constructed piles that create a luxurious feel.

A cut-loop carpet is a combination of elements of the two main finishes.

WILL I SEETHE JOINS IN MY CARPET?

Like the joins you can see in furniture fabric, the same is happening for your carpet when two cut edges come together to make one surface. Different styles of carpet join better and are less visible than others. Unfortunately, nobody can guarantee joins that are completely invisible.

3. Understand carpet specifications and ratings

The Australian Carpet Institute provides yellow and blue identification tags to carpets that have been graded specifically for residential use. The labeling system uses factors such as appearance retention and durability. The residential rating system offers a maximum of 6 stars for each graded carpet.

Residential Light Duty: suitable for bedroom with light traffic flow

Residential Medium Duty: suitable for living room, entertainment area with light to medium traffic flow

Residential Heavy Duty: suitable for hallway, entertainment area with heavy traffic flow



EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT LAMINATE UNDERLAYS

Have you heard that old joke, what does a Mexican put under his carpet?

Underlay, underlay!

But seriously, underlay is a vital part of any type of flooring, especially for laminate due to its composition. Choosing suitable underlay for your flooring project is important to make sure that your laminate will last for years to come.

What is a laminate underlay?

Laminate underlay is basically a thin, flexible sheet of resilient material that is installed on top of a subfloor in order to act as a base for the laminate. It is commonly made from thin polyethylene or polypropylene.

Underlay or underlayment is used to help protect your laminate boards by absorbing the moisture coming from the subfloor below. It also helps in minimizing footstep noises as it adds to the thickness of the laminate boards boosting their sound-absorbing qualities, plus it provides additional thermal insulation for your floor to help make your laminate more comfortable underfoot.

Do I need underlay for laminate flooring?

Yes, you will need underlayment for your laminate flooring to help protect your new laminate flooring from the damage that moisture in the subfloor can cause. The underlay will act as a moisture barrier and

it will also make the floor more comfortable. But be sure to check what kind of laminate flooring you are purchasing, as some laminate plans or tiles now come with built-in underlay, saving you from the additional step of installing it separately. Your flooring consultant should be able to tell you if the underlay is part of the laminate or if you will need to install it separately.

Types of underlays available

There are different types of underlays, each with its unique features. With this in mind, it is important to consider some important factors before selecting the most ideal underlay. The type of the subfloor, noise reduction, your budget and your preferred use of the space should be key among the factors to consider.

The main types of underlay are foam, rubber and felt.

Foam: This type of underlay was originally created as a cheaper version of rubber underlay which is considered the superior option. That being said, the construction of this type of underlay has improved over the years so it is now on par with its competitors. It most often comes in rolls and is relatively easy to install.

Rubber: Is the most popular type of underlay and is suitable for a wide range of flooring options. It is durable, breathable and 'springy' so it feels great when you are walking on it! It can come in either sheets or rolls so you can choose what is easiest for you to use!





HOW TO CLEAN AND MAINTAIN VINYL FLOORING

Vinyl is the go-to flooring for many people because of its durability, affordability, and limitless design options. This guide provides guidance on how to best clean and maintain your floors.

Note that if you have just installed a new vinyl flooring in your house, it is recommended to use a damp mop immediately. Then do not scrub or wash for at least 72 hours and follow the below guidance to maintain and wash your floors.

How to wash your vinyl flooring

Use hot water

Best is to wash your vinyl floor with plain hot water which helps remove grease and other microbes but you can also use neutral detergent.

Don't use these products

DO NOT use abrasive cleaners, or "mop and shine" products. These products may leave a dull film on your floor.

DO NOT use paste wax or solvent-based polishes.

DO NOT use highly alkaline 'floor strippers' to clean the floor covering. Highly alkaline solutions have the potential to damage the adhesive bonds between the planks.

How to maintain your vinyl floor

Sweep or vacuum regularly

Remove dust by regularly using a broom or vacuum cleaner. By making a habit out of it, you will prevent dirt and dust from building up on the floor which is one of the leading causes of scratches and wears.

Note:We do not recommend vacuums that have a beater bar since it can visibly damage your flooring surface. Additionally, we do not recommend electric brooms with hard plastic bottoms with no padding as use may result in discolouration and de-glossing. The use of steam mops or similar is not recommended.

Wipe up spills immediately

Whenever coffee or any other liquid spills on your vinyl floor, wipe it out as soon as possible. It will prevent the liquid from sipping through and reduce dampness on the floor. Never use highly abrasive scrubbing tools on any resilient floor.







Keep them looking great!

Use furniture pads

The sharp edges of the furniture can cause damage such as scratches or gouges. Using furniture pads will protect your floors and keep them in good condition for longer.

Use saucers under houseplants

Houseplants cause dampness on the vinyl floor as a result of exposure to water. Best is to keep your plants houseplants sitting in a saucer to catch excess water.

Keep hot items at a safe distance


Heaters, coals or ashes can destroy your vinyl floor. Keep hot sources at a safe height from the vinyl floor.

Use walk-off mats

Place a walk-off mat at outside entrances to reduce the amount of dirt brought into your home. We strongly recommend mats without a latex or rubber backing since these backings can cause permanent discolouration.

HOWTO CARE FOR YOUR ENGINEERED TIMBER FLOORS

Now that you are the proud owner of some stunning engineered timber flooring, you might be wondering how to take care of them. At Parrys we want every one of our customers to love their new flooring for many years to come, so we have put together some of our top tips to help your new floors keep looking as beautiful as the day you had them installed!

Cleaning

Engineered timber flooring is still made from timber, so it requires almost the same cleaning methods as any other type of hardwood flooring. Follow our cleaning tips below for taking care of your gorgeous new engineered timber flooring.

- Use a dry microfiber dust mop to pick up dirt and debris from the floor. Microfiber is perfect for gathering dirt and dust without the risk of surface damage, you can buy microfiber cloths, mops and cleaning mitts from many stores.
- Use either a broom or a vacuum cleaner with a soft flooring attachment. A soft bristled broom is all you need to help clear your engineered timber flooring of dirt and debris, but for those who do not like sweeping, you can use your vacuum cleaner with a soft flooring attachment. The "regular" vacuum cleaner attachment can cause scratches and damage to engineered timber flooring.
- Don't use harsh cleaners. Wax-based cleaners, powerful
 detergents, or steel wool should never be used to clean engineered
 timber flooring. You should only try to clean your engineered timber
 flooring with a damp mop or cloth where possible, but your Parry's
 Flooring consultant can recommend some cleaning agents for very
 dirty flooring.
- Never use a steam cleaner on your engineered timber flooring.
 While a steam cleaner can be a useful tool for cleaning other
 flooring, it should never be used on engineered timber flooring.
 The steam can damage the wood surface by forcing water into the
 veneer and the top layer of timber.

Maintenance

Once you have seen how stunning your new engineered timber flooring is now that it's spick and span, we know you'll want to keep it that way! Below are some maintenance tips to help you reduce damage to your flooring and help keep them looking stunning.

• Clean up spills as soon as possible. While engineered timber flooring is less susceptible to water damage than polished hardwood flooring, prolonged exposure to liquids can result in damage.

- Watch what shoes you wear indoors. Avoid walking on your floors
 with high heeled shoes or boots because they can cause damage to
 the upper wear layer of the floor. Try to avoid wearing shoes inside
 and encourage your guests to do the same to help protect your
 engineered timber flooring.
- Keep mats and rugs at entranceways. This will keep dirt, moisture, sand, and debris out of the house and off of your floor. It will also help you avoid scratches, keeping the upper wear layer and finish of your floor safe and intact for longer.
- Try to sweep/vacuum daily and always sweep or dust before you mop. Remove as much dirt and debris before mopping to prevent abrasive particles from scratching the surface. Lighter-coloured types of engineered timber flooring such as blackbutt timber floors or spotted gum timber floors may show dirt more easily, so it is always a good idea to keep them as clean as possible!
- Place all houseplants and furniture on felt pads. These can be bought from a wide range of department and hardware stores and will help to avoid nicks and scratches.

Accidental Cleaning

We all have those clumsy moments where we spill and drop things, we are only human! We have put together some of the most common accidents your floors might face and how to fix them.

- **Spills.** As we have mentioned previously, it is always important to clean up spills as soon as they happen to avoid damage to your floor. If a simple wipe with a damp cloth won't clean up the mess, you may have to break out the big guns, by using cleaning liquid. Never use a harsh cleaning liquid, or use a home concoction with bleach, vinegar, or ammonia! Only ever use a cleaning liquid recommended by your Parrys flooring consultant.
- **Damage.** If you have damaged a part of your engineered timber flooring, don't despair! Small nicks, indents or damaged parts can be filled with wood putty that can be bought from your local hardware store. For any damage that is more substantial, speak to your Parry flooring consultant for their recommendations.
