

SURFACE TEXTURE ON HYBRID FLOORING: DOES IT ATTRACT DIRT?

Hybrid flooring has taken the world by storm – and demand for this exquisite and revolutionary product is showing no signs of abating.

Fusing the best attributes of laminate and vinyl, hybrid flooring delivers stunning hardwood-look floating floors that are rigid and robust, as well as voguish and versatile.

Parrys offers both textured and non-textured finishes, prompting many buyers to wonder if textured hybrid floors attract more dirt or are harder to clean.

Let's take a look!

Q Why textured hybrid flooring?

A A textured surface enhances the visual appeal, character and depth of hybrid floors, helping them to look and feel more like a natural substance ie. timber.

Added bonus #1: Texture also creates more grip, making this an excellent slip-resistant flooring choice and ideal for high-traffic spaces and homes with younger or older family members.

Q Does textured hybrid flooring attract or trap more dirt?

A The slight texture may offer more spaces for dirt to accumulate than a smooth finish, however, the grooves, slight height and shadows of textured hybrid floors do a better job of hiding dust and debris in between regular cleaning!

Added bonus #2: Hybrid floors are 100% waterproof, making

them great for homes with young kids and pets.

Q Are textured hybrid floors harder to clean?

A These floors are quite simple to clean, particularly as they're incredibly hardy and won't crack, buckle or lift with changing temperatures.

Use soft-bristle vacuums or microfibre mops to clean regularly and remove loose dirt. Warm water is enough to keep them in pristine condition.

Added bonus #3: Hybrid floors are stain resistant and odour proof AND textured selections are great for disguising rare scuffs and scratches.


Q What else do I need to know in terms of maintenance?

A Most importantly, do not use any chemicals on hybrid flooring.

- Avoid scrubbing, as it may wear down the texture.
- Lift, rather than drag or push, furniture along it or move items with a mat or towel underneath to prevent damage.
- Avoid using steam mops on any hybrid floors (even though they are fully waterproof).

Added bonus #4: These floors are impressively hardwearing and bring timeless appeal to any style of home.





FLOORING MYTHS DEBUNKED, WHAT YOU NEEDTO KNOW FOR YOUR RENOVATIONS.

Whether you're flipping a house or overhauling your own home, installing new floors can be transformational.

But wading through the many flooring myths that abound can be confusing – so we've put together some facts to help debunk the top 3!

Flooring Myth #1: All engineered hardwood is the same

No, not all engineered hardwood is the same.

This is not only due to the many varying styles of engineered timber floorboards, but also because differences exist in their quality and construction. These differences can affect longevity, durability and stability.

On top of deciding what material and finish best suits you, the key thing with engineered hardwood flooring is how thick the top layer is. This natural layer that you see and walk on is made of genuine hardwood, so it boasts the beauty of solid timber floors but is more economical because it uses less timber. If this layer is thicker, it can impact cost and affect how stable the floor is, as well as how quickly it wears.

While price is also driven by the materials and finishes chosen, engineered hardwood is always more economical than solid timber.

Flooring Myth #2: Vinyl flooring is dead

Mention vinyl and visions of your grandparent's garish green, red and orange floors may come to mind!

However, with outdated vintage offerings having been given the flick in favour of sleek wood-like styles in a variety of tones and textures, vinyl floors are experiencing an impressive revival.

Not only does vinyl look better these days, but it's also made better. Improved technology means vinyl floors now feel more natural, enhancing their attractiveness as a flooring of choice.

Whether it be sheet vinyl, vinyl plank or luxury vinyl plank, it's also an affordable, long lasting, versatile (it can even safely be installed in 'wet' rooms like bathrooms and laundries) and easy-to-clean choice.

Flooring Myth #3: Carpet is bad for allergies

When it comes to asthma and allergies, carpet has been given a bad name, but this longstanding myth has now been busted.

We know now that what matters most is what's present in the air and a German study found wall-to-wall carpet dramatically reduces airborne dust compared to hard flooring.



SPRING INTO COMFORT, THE BEST CARPETS FOR A COSY HOME.

Dreaming of a freshly carpeted home that's welcoming and warm?

Education is essential to creating your cosy vision, so here's what you need to know to kickstart your journey.

Fibre material, pile style & density are key

Home is really all about feeling safe and there's not much more comforting than walking on plush carpet.

How soft carpet feels underfoot is based on 3 main things:

1 Fibre material

The type of material carpet is made from dramatically impacts how it feels when you walk or rest on it. Wool carpet is notoriously – and naturally – sumptuous and satisfying.

Synthetic options, such as nylon and polypropylene, offer strong fibres and deliver carpet that's highly durable, versatile and affordable, as well as comfy.

2 Pile style

Pile refers to how long a carpet's material tufts are, as well as how they're finished. The main 3 types are cut, loop and combination pile.

Cut pile means the tops of the fibre loops have been cut so the strands stand up, making the carpet feel lusher and look more refined compared to loop pile, where the loops aren't cut. Carpets can also combine cut and level loop tufts for a nice, smooth result.

3 Density

How many fibres a carpet is made of and how closely they sit together – or its density / thickness – plays a big part in how cushiony it is. More fibres = increased softness.

Note: Underlay quality also has an effect on how lush carpet feels.

Consider Foot Traffic

It's imperative to consider how often carpet will be walked on.

As bedrooms don't see as much foot traffic, many choose a superplush, warmth-creating carpet for these spaces so they're extra welcoming.

Note: If you don't like vacuuming streaks on your carpet, choose a loop pile!

In family living rooms, playrooms or lounges, there may be more foot traffic and so, though you no doubt want softness, it's often good to opt for something that bit more resilient.






